LISTENING ACTIVITY

- 1. Preface listening with a brief intro: "There are so many different kinds of dreams: silly, scary, and strange."
- 2. Explain that you will listen to several pieces of music inspired by dreams. Use the <u>student</u> worksheet to compare and contrast the pieces. Invite students to answer, for each piece: What kind of dream do you hear?

- <u>"Träumerei" [Reverie] by Robert Schumann</u> (video approx. 3 minutes)
- Dream a Little Dream of Me by Ella Fitzgerald (video approx. 3.5 minutes)
- <u>5th movement of Symphonie fantastique by Hector Berlioz</u> (video approx. 2.5 minutes)
