FUN FACTS

- Trumpets, like other brass instruments, sometimes play with mutes. A mute changes the <u>timbre</u>, or sound, of the instrument. Mutes are especially common in jazz.
- Trumpets look pretty small compared to many other brass instruments, but they have a lot of tubing wrapped up in coils. If you were to stretch out that tubing, it would be about 6.5 feet long!
- Trumpets didn't always have valves! The invention of valves in the 1800s made it easier for trumpet players to reach more pitches.
